Why read?

Read Write Inc

- Structured daily programme teaching the sounds that make up words in the English language
 - Set 1 - Single letter sounds and 6 diagraphs
 - Set 2 - The long vowels - diagraphs and trigraphs (“2 letters, 1 sound”, “3 letters, 1 sound”)
 - Set 3 - Alternative pronunciation / spelling (“same sound, different appearance”)

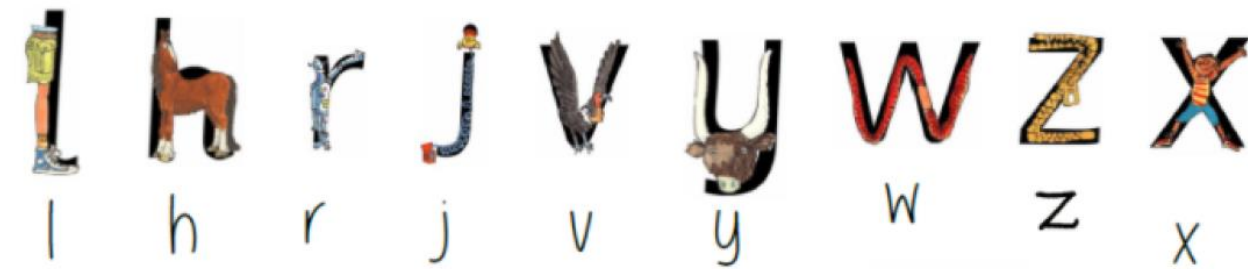
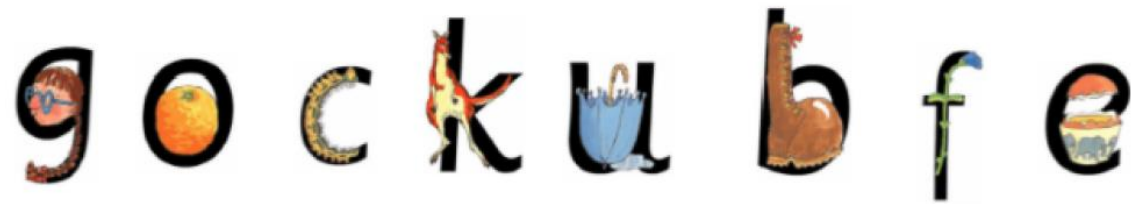

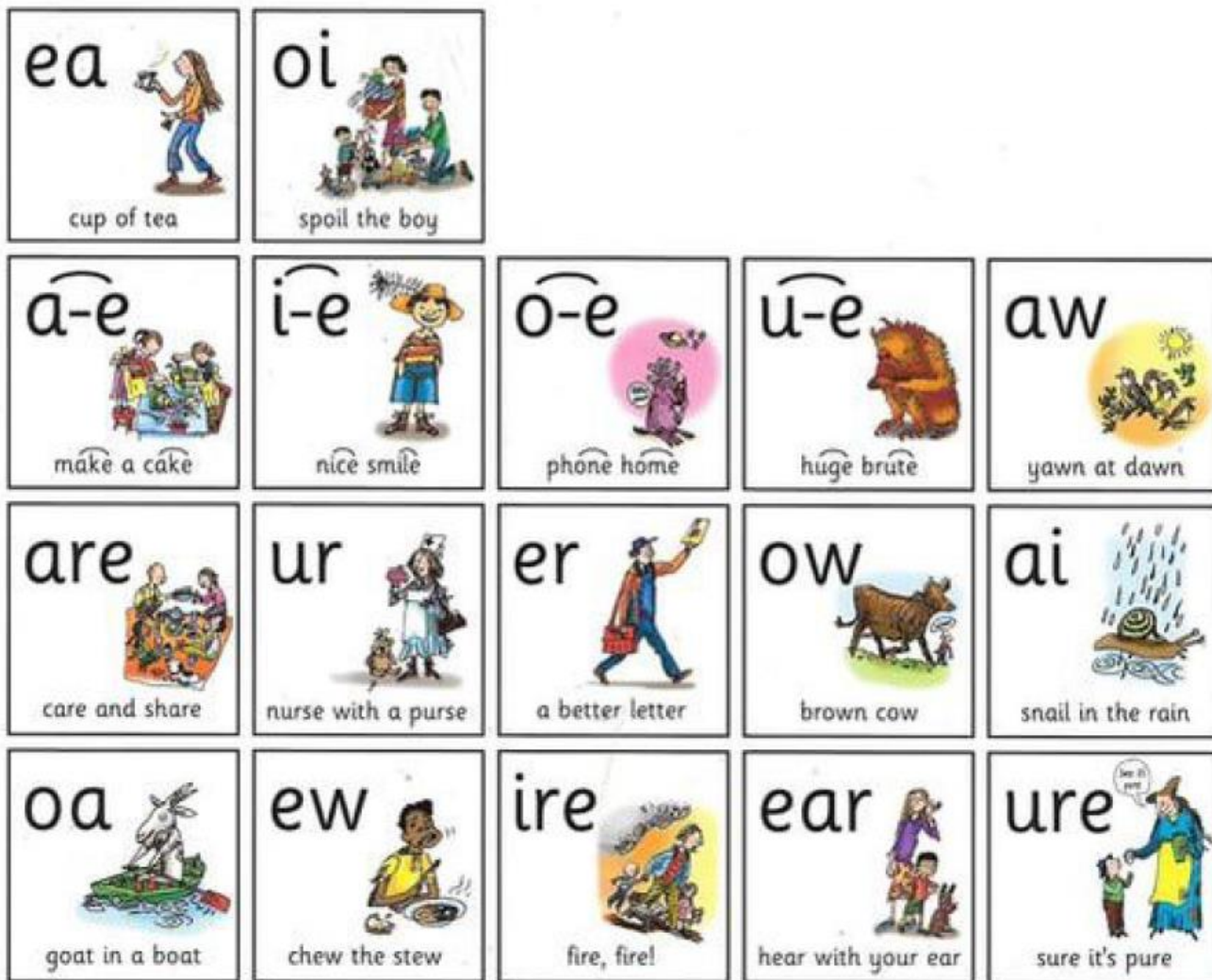
How to say the Sounds

Set 3 - Year 1

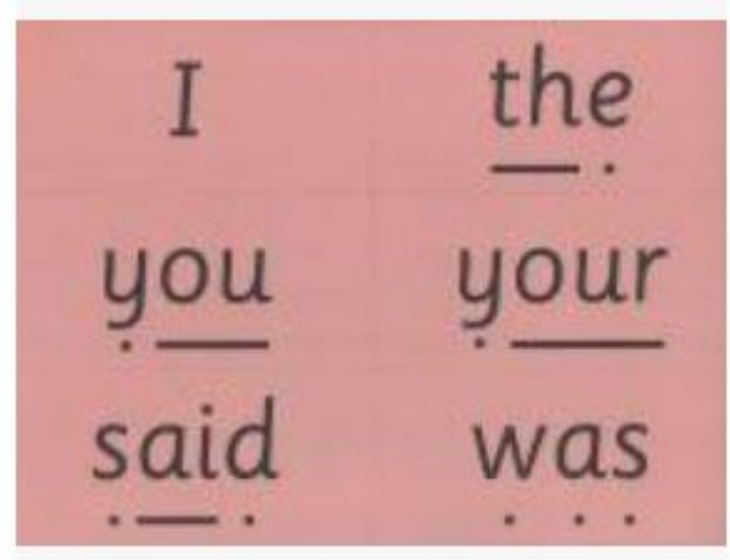
Green Words

- Words that children can go ahead and read
- Made up of sounds they have already learnt
- Sound buttons to identify the phonemes



The Red Words

- Not phonically decodable
- Also known as tricky words or sight vocabulary
- Taught in phases

1. Practise Set 1 sounds and Red Words
2. Ditty cards (blending)
3. After 10 ditties - RWI reading books
4. Accelerated Reader programme
