Writing Composition

- Say sentence out loud first
- Write the sentence
- Re-read to check it makes sense
- Discuss their writing with peers
- Read aloud their writing
- Link to grammar punctuation and spelling







Handwriting

- Lower case and capital letters
- Start every letter on the line
- Don't forget to get ready!
- Will join when confidence increases

In maths we teach for understanding

Using concrete objects (cubes/counters) to help children understand
