# Why read?

## Read Write Inc

- Structured daily programme teaching the sounds that make up words in the English language
  - •Set 1 Single letter sounds and 6 diagraphs
  - •Set 2 The long vowels diagraphs and trigraphs ("2 letters, 1 sound", "3 letters, 1 sound)
  - •Set 3 Alternative pronunciation / spelling ("same sound, different appearance")

# Green Words

- Words that children can go ahead and read
- Made up of sounds they have already learnt
- Sound buttons to identify the phonemes





## The Red Words

- Not phonically decodable
- Also known as tricky words or sight vocabulary
- Taught in phases





## A Typical Phonics Lesson



#### Review

Practise sounds already learned



#### **Teach** Teach today's new sound



#### **Practise** Blending for reading Segmenting for spelling



#### Apply Write a sentence using words with the new sound



## **Reading Books and Phonics**

- 1. Practise Set 1 sounds and Red Words
- 2. Ditty cards (blending)
- 3. After 10 ditties RWI reading books
- 4. Accelerated Reader programme

Reading at home consolidates what has been taught in school Don't worry if it seems easy - we are building secure foundations!



- At least 3 times a week!
- Practise speed sounds
- Share a story book
- Talk about what is happening
- Enjoy it!
